Your Role

Arrive on time, wear secure footwear, follow
guide instructions, upload your best photos
and videos, and bring great energy.

Mission Timeline

8:00 AM

Rally at Bailey Resort

Paid rafting guests meeting with the group should arrive ready for the group rollout.

Morning

Group Rollout

Final head count, vehicle coordination, and departure for Bakersfield.

Arrival

River's End Check-In

Parking, waiver verification, equipment fitting, and safety briefing.

Adventure

Whitewater Rafting

Follow guide instructions, paddle together, stay hydrated, and enjoy the river.

Afterward

Dry Off & Reset

Change into dry clothes, secure wet gear, and prepare for the evening celebration.

7:00 PM

Base Camp BBQ

Food, music, photos, stories, and Andrea's birthday celebration at Bailey Resort.

Rally & Arrival

Choose the arrival option that matches your plan. The group instructions below override the older 20-minute arrival language in the archived trip packet.

Option 1: Meet the Group

Meet at Bailey Resort at 8:00 AM for the group meet-up and rollout. The exact Bailey Resort address will be shared directly by the Bailey family and posted on the event website. Be fueled, dressed for rafting, and ready to leave on time.

Option 2: Drive Directly

Go directly to River's End Rafting Center and arrive one full hour before the group's scheduled rafting time. This extra time is for parking, check-in, waiver processing, equipment fitting, and the safety briefing.

Do Not Miss the Rollout

Everyone has already paid. No RSVP or payment collection is needed. The priority is punctuality. If you are running late or changing your arrival plan, contact the event host immediately at 562-410-7362.

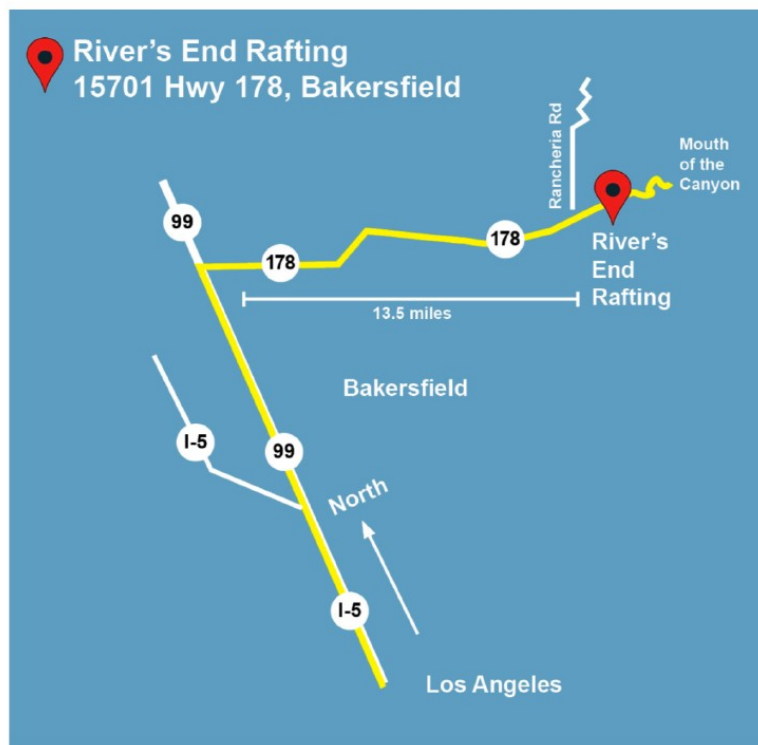
From Los Angeles Area

Take I-5 North, continue to CA-99 North, then take Exit 26A for CA-178 East/Rosedale Highway. Continue east toward Rio Bravo Ranch. River's End is on the right before the mouth of the canyon.

Watch for us on the right! (at Rio Bravo Ranch)

River Ready: What to Wear



SHOES REQUIRED

Swimsuit

Wear underneath quick-drying clothes.

Shorts / Tank / T-Shirt

Choose lightweight, comfortable pieces that can get wet.

Secure Water Shoes

Use old sneakers or strap-on sandals. Avoid loose flip-flops.

Sunscreen

Apply before arrival and bring extra for reapplication.

Inexpensive Sunglasses

Use a retainer strap if possible.

Adventure Hat

Choose one you do not mind getting wet or losing.

Gear Check

Bring This

- Towel for drying off
- Complete dry change of clothes
- Plastic bag or dry bag for wet clothing
- Refillable water bottle
- Required personal medication
- Waterproof phone pouch, if bringing a phone
- Positive energy and patience during group check-in

Leave This Behind

- Pets
- Expensive jewelry
- Alcohol
- Drugs
- Loose or unsecured valuables
- Anything that cannot safely get wet

River's End may refuse service to anyone under the influence, without a refund.

Smart Packing Tip

Pack one small rafting bag and one separate dry-change bag. Label your belongings. Keep valuables locked out of sight in your vehicle and avoid bringing irreplaceable items to the river.

Safety & Waiver

The river is fun because it is real adventure.

Whitewater rafting involves moving water, rocks, debris, slippery surfaces, paddles, changing weather, heat, cold water, and the possibility of falling into the river. Listen closely to your guide, wear all assigned safety equipment, stay with your group, and speak up about medical or physical concerns before launch.

Before Launch

Complete the participant agreement and assumption-of-risk form. Participants under 18 require the parent/guardian section. Hydrate, apply sunscreen, and tell the guide about relevant health or mobility concerns.

On the River

Keep your life jacket and helmet secured. Follow paddle commands. Hold the raft safety line when instructed. Do not stand in moving water. Stay calm and follow rescue instructions if you enter the water.

Important Source Note

Safety, footwear, waiver, and prohibited-item guidance is based on the River's End trip packet supplied for this project. That packet is dated 2019. Any current instructions from River's End or the event organizer supersede older packet language.

Parking & Check-In

Follow on-site signs for the main rafting-center parking area, additional parking, and the check-in point. Do not block roadways or equipment access.

Upload Best Practices

Upload original-quality files. Add your name and a useful caption. Avoid duplicates, screenshots, unrelated files, or anything you would not want included in Andrea's keepsake.

Great Moments to Capture

Arrival smiles, group selfies, safety-briefing moments, action shots, scenic river views, post-rafting reactions, BBQ fun, cake, dancing, and heartfelt birthday moments.

Privacy & Permission

Only upload media you have the right to share. By contributing, you allow the Bailey family to include the material in the event gallery, private keepsakes, memory book, and highlight video. The organizer may remove inappropriate or unrelated uploads.

Birthday Message Vault

Leave Andrea something she can keep

Visit the website and leave a written birthday message, favorite memory, funny story, photo, audio greeting, or short video. These messages will be collected as part of Andrea's Adventure Time Capsule and used to create a meaningful post-event gift.

PRIVATE SURPRISE

Please do not spoil the message collection for Andrea before the reveal.

Message Prompts

- What do you appreciate most about Andrea?
- What is your favorite memory together?
- What do you wish for her next year?
- What made today special?
